This is a 90-minute exam comprised of three parts:

- Part I: Identification of works by composers in the syllabus, based on played excerpts
- Part II: Questions about musical techniques and styles, based on played excerpts from the Middle Ages through the present
- Part III: Short-answer questions on musical terms, concepts, genres, forms, and composers

As an additional note, the Music Exemption Exam may only be taken once, during a student's first semester at Columbia. It is offered only during the Fall semester of each academic year. Students matriculating for the first time in January may take the test the following Fall semester.
